

411 How do you revise?

There are many different ways to revise. The most effective ways are those where you do something with the material making it meaningful for yourself.

Examples of effective approaches:

1. Rewriting the material into flowcharts, mind maps or other diagrams.
2. Making lists of the main points in bullet point format.
3. Generating vocabulary lists.
4. Solving problems from worksheets, textbook, past papers.
5. Summarizing material on index cards.
6. Discussing the material with other people.
7. Making links between different topics.
